## It's That Time Again! March 10, 2009

Included with this issue of the newsletter is the invoice for your annual assessment. Your Board has worked very hard to keep your cost from going up, while still maintaining the quality of services that we want in our neighborhood. This has not been easy.

Any time a home owner fails to pay, or even delays paying their assessment, the rest of us need to come up with the money to cover the shortfall. If a resident decides to ignore or

reinterpret the covenants and rules we all agreed to when we bought our homes, it can result in extra cost to the Association, and therefore to each of us as members. It is up to all homeowners to see to it that the covenants are properly and fairly enforced.

As a result of the work your Board did last year, there are now rules in place that allow the Association to recover the money spent enforcing compliance, but we all know that this can take

time to collect. In the meantime, we have to provide the up front funds to pay for the enforcement.

The best thing that each of us can do in difficult times like these is to treat our neighbors as we'd like to be treated, and keep our neighborhood looking like one that we'd like to buy into. We're all in this together, and the better Kingswood looks, the more desirable a place it is to live and therefore to buy.

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## *Your neighborhood needs you!*

### **Web Site Coordinator**

After the great work done last year by past Board member Sam Lombardo,

the web site became a much more effective tool for communication. Hits to the site increased very significantly, and many of you agreed to receive Association communication via the site and e-mail.
